

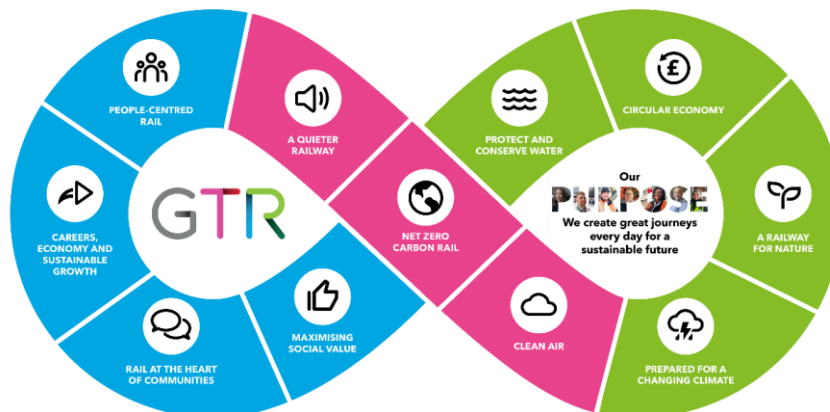
GTR Environment & Energy Statement
